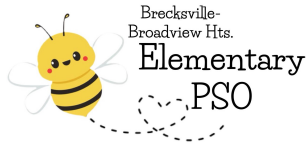




**BBH Elementary School PSO Meeting Minutes

All students who receive a tootle will be recognized on Fridays with a picture and a ride down the slide for all! ● We are also hosting our first Be Your Best BeeSTRO next week to recognize one student from each class for being PAX leaders and “Being their best”. ● Each month we will be focusing on one character trait and teaching students what each means. This month is Accountability. Students will focus on owning their choices and being responsible for their actions. Three students from every grade level will be chosen at the end of each month who



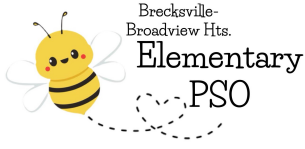

Teachers are available throughout the year to conference with parents. We always communicate to parents that if they wish to conference about their child’s progress...contact the teacher and a mutually agreed upon time will be scheduled for a conference. • The fall administration of the Reading OST assessment will be given to all third grade students on the morning of Wednesday October 25th, and Thursday, October 26th. Results from the assessment will be used to guide instruction and to support students with identified areas of weaknesses and building on areas of strength. • Halloween parties will be on October 27th. Room parents have begun planning. Parents should not arrive more than fifteen minutes prior to the party time. Costumes may be worn to school, but should not be distracting to our learning that day. Guidelines were sent in this week’s newsletter. • Just a reminder that there will be no school for students on October 13 and October 19th.

Educational Enrichment VP: Merri Gunzler	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Science DZ - 1st grade program, repeat in all 4 quarters, science experiments ● YAD - 11/18/23 @ CLE public library, transportation provided, 4th and 5th grade teams, students fill out application with 1-2 sentences on why they want to be chosen, lottery for 6 students/grade, \$10/student if selected, submission link in newsletter this week, preference to students who have never gone before ● Culture Night - 11/10/23 @ HS, no food at tables, food trucks available for purchase, looking for families to feature their heritage ● Assemblies - 3rd grade will not be doing Great Lakes Theater Program due to scheduling issues, working with grade level leads to choose assemblies, most likely will not occur until 2nd semester

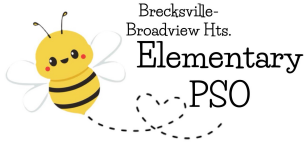

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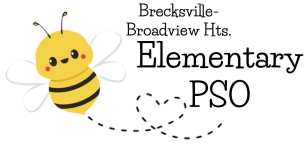
